LIFE STAGE

Puppy < 12 months

REGULAR HEALTH CARE

- Full physical exam
- Fecal +/- de-worming
- DHPP vaccine at 8, 12, and 16 wks
- Bordetella vaccine at 12 weeks if boarded or commonly in contact with other dogs
- Rabies vaccine at 16 weeks
- Start heartworm prevention if < 6 months
- Heartworm test if > 6 months then start on heartworm prevention
- Start flea/tick control
- Full physical exam yearly

SPECIAL PROCEDURES

- Spay/Neuter
- Preanesthetic blood work and urinalysis

Adult - 1 to 7 years

- Discuss appropriate vaccine schedule for life style
- Discuss dental care
- Rabies vaccine every 3 years
- DHPP vaccine every 3 years after first annual vaccination
- Bordetella vaccine yearly if boarded or commonly in contact with other dogs
- Heartworm test yearly
- Fecal +/- de-worming yearly
- Continue heartworm, flea, tick and intestinal parasite prevention appropriate for lifestyle

- Dental cleaning as needed
- Preanesthetic blood work and urinalysis

Golden years > 7 years

- Full physical exam every 6 months to one year
- Monitor for weight changes
- Discuss age related diet changes
- Modify vaccine schedule appropriate for age and lifestyle
- Discuss dental care
- Discuss ongoing health problems
- Discuss arthritis and pain management
- Rabies vaccine every 3 years
- Bordetella vaccine yearly if boarded or commonly in contact with other dogs
- Heartworm test yearly
- Fecal +/- de-worming yearly
- Continue heartworm, flea, tick and intestinal parasite prevention if appropriate for lifestyle

- Full lab work at least every 3 years (CBC, chemistry, electrolytes, urinalysis)
- Thoracic and abdominal radiographs if indicated by physical exam or lab work
- Dental cleaning as needed

LIFE STAGE

Kitten < 12 months

REGULAR HEALTH CARE

- Full physical exam
- Felv/FIV test at first visit
- Fecal or de-worming
- FVRCP at 8, and 12 weeks
- Rabies vaccine at 16 weeks
- Felv vaccine at 12 and 16 weeks if going outdoors
- Start flea/tick and ear mite control if appropriate for lifestyle

SPECIAL PROCEDURES

- Spay/Neuter
- Pre-anesthetic blood work and urinalysis

Adult - 1 to 7 years

- Full physical exam yearly
- Discuss appropriate vaccine schedule for life style
- Discuss dental care
- Rabies every three years
- FVRCP every three years after first annual vaccination
- Felv vaccine yearly if outdoors
- Felv/FIV test yearly if outdoors
- Fecal or de-worming yearly
- Flea/tick, ear mite prevention if appropriate for lifestyle

- Dental cleaning as needed
- Pre-anesthetic blood work and urinalysis

Mature Adult - 7 years to 11 years

- Full physical exam every year
- Monitor for weight changes
- Discuss age related diet changes
- Modify vaccine schedule appropriate for age and lifestyle
- Discuss dental care
- Rabies every three years
- Fecal +/- de-worming yearly
- Flea/tick, ear mite prevention if appropriate for lifestyle

- Full lab work at least every 3 years (CBC, chemistry, electrolytes, thyroid, urinalysis)
- Dental cleaning as needed

Golden years >11 years

- Full physical exam every 6 months to one year
- Monitor for weight changes
- Discuss age related diet changes
- Discuss any changes in behavior, appetite, water intake
- Discuss appropriate vaccine schedule
- Discuss dental care
- Fecal or de-worming yearly
- Flea/tick prevention if appropriate for lifestyle

- Full lab work yearly (CBC, chemistry, electrolytes, thyroid, urinalysis)
- Thoracic and abdominal radiographs if indicated by physical exam or lab work
- Dental cleaning as needed
